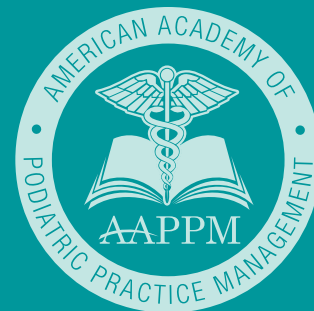
CONTINUING EDUCATION CERTIFICATE AND EVALUATION

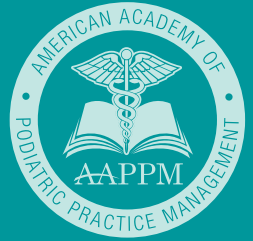
